

KRUUSE Silk

Multifilament, braided: For secure knot tying and easy handling
Coated (wax): For easy knot tying and smooth passage through tissue
Non-absorbable: Provides permanent tensile strength

KRUUSE Silk is a natural, braided and coated suture. As silk is a natural fiber, more tissue reaction can be expected using this type of suture compared to synthetic sutures.

Natural silk contains two glycoproteins: Fibroin and sericin. Sericin can cause an immune response and is removed from KRUUSE Silk.

Absorption:

- Non-absorbable

Chemical composition:

- KRUUSE Silk is composed of 100% fibroin (Sericin, which can cause an immune response, is removed)

Colour:

- Black

Indications:

KRUUSE Silk sutures are indicated for soft tissue approximation and ligation, where permanent support is indicated, including:

- Ophthalmic surgery
- Vascular and cardiovascular surgery
- Neurosurgery
- Dental surgery
- Ligation

- USP 4-0 to 0
- EP 1.5 to 3.5
