

KRUISE Promilene

Monofilament: For smooth passage through tissue and high tissue compatibility

Synthetic: For minimal tissue reaction

Non-absorbable: Provides permanent tensile strength

KRUISE Promilene sutures are coloured blue for easy identification during surgery. The monofilament and synthetic properties of the suture give a smooth surface, minimal tissue reaction and decreased incidence of infection and trauma.

The suture is resistant to repeated bending.

Absorption:

- Non-absorbable

Chemical composition:

- KRUISE Promilene is composed of an isotactic crystalline stereoisomer of polypropylene, a polymer of propylene

Colour:

- Blue

Indications:

KRUISE Promilene is commonly used in soft tissue approximation and ligation where a permanent support is needed. Areas of use include:

- Skin closure
- Ophthalmic surgery
- Vascular and cardiovascular surgery
- Neurosurgery
